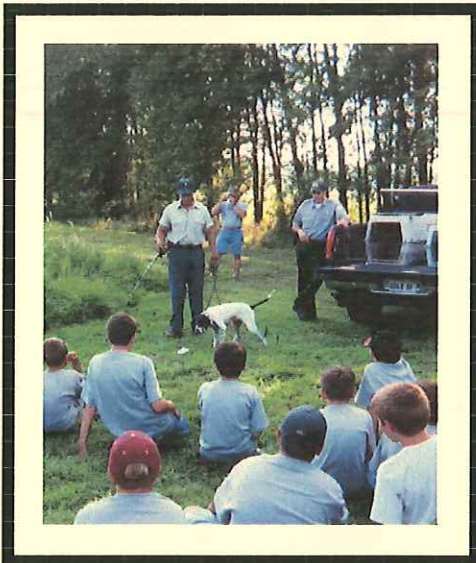
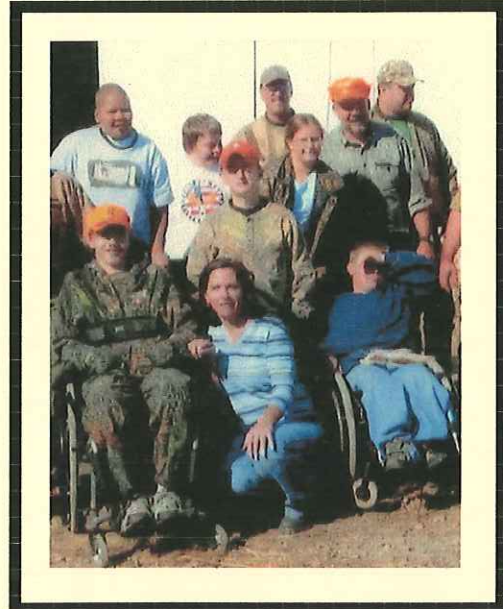
YOUTH EDUCATION AND OUTDOOR RESOURCE FUND, INC.

Incorporated as a 501-C-3 organization to accept tax deductible donations to support youth activities, camps, scholarships and education. Mission: To encourage, instill and perpetuate an understanding of, and appreciation for, conservation and natural resources, including the wise and safe use of those resources, within the youth of Illinois through a variety of educational programs and outdoor experiences.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES AND CAMPS

The annual Youth Skills Camp is a 3-day camp for sixty campers, where many types of outdoor activities are discussed and the campers get hands-on opportunities to shoot shotguns, muzzleloaders, bows and handle and ride horses. Several new programs have been implemented, including a 1-day Youth Outdoor Skills Day Camp, a Youth Archery Hunt and IFOR Deer Camps to be held at affiliate organization's facilities.

Tax deductible contributions for the events support the food, door prizes, raffles, presentations, purchasing and maintaining firearms, archery equipment, fishing gear and trailers.



SCHOLARSHIPS

IFOR has four one-thousand dollar scholarships awarded each year to junior/senior class and graduate students in the fields of biology and conservation. We plan to expand this scholarship program to 9 annually to 4 universities, plus 1 scholarship each year to a member's family from donations and grants to the Youth Fund.

KIDS WITH DISABILITIES

IFOR currently supports, both financially and with volunteers, special hunts for disabled and terminally ill children.



PUBLICATIONS

A goal of the Youth Fund is the design and publication of a monthly magazine, supported in part by paid advertising, to support solid natural resource programs.
